married 15 Feb 1843 in Steinhart

born 1815 Bechhofen, died 18 Aug 1890 Oettingen (grave 040)
parents = Raphael Schuelein + wife Berta (Besla) nee Gutmann (C)

19 Apr 1891 - 21 Aug 1948 (died in Oruru, Bolivia)
parents = Salomon Fisch (owner of furniture factory
in Ludwigshafen) + wife Emma nee Hoechstaedter

couple had 2 children = **Stephen** 1923 + **Renate** 1926

whole family emigrated to the USA

(b) Paula Heymann

24 Jun 1892 - 1968 (died in Edmonton, Canada) married on 25 Jun 1923 in Frankfurt/Main Lothar Owen (born Offenbacher) from Fuerth merchant, partner of A Hess in Munich 02 Jun 1881 - 1969 (died in Edmonton, Canada) parents = Philipp Offenbacher + wife Cilly nee Goldschmidt

sons (born in Munich) = Peter 1924 + Klaus 1926

Lothar + family lived in Frankfurt by 1938 when Lothar + Paula + Klaus emigrated to Bolivia via Chile, and finally in 1946 moved to Edmonton in Canada with help of son Peter who had emigrated in 1938 to Edmonton, where he was given shelter by Harry Freeman. Meanwhile Klaus had adopted "Claude" as first name. Peter died in 2006, Claude died in 2011.

- (A) Building was sold again by Nathan's sons in 1890/91 to Abraham Emanuel, who lived in Oettingen and who later gave this property to his son Louis Emanuel, who owned it until he died on 6 Jan 1934 in Oettingen.
- (B) Moses Heymann died on 05 Jun 1853 in Steinhart, his wife Gietel died on 18 Jun 1869 in Oettingen (grave 194).
- (C) Raphael Schuelein was born in Braunsbach? around 1786 and died in Bechhhofen during winter of 1855/56. His father might have been a Rabbi. Raphael had married Berta nee Gutmann, who was born in Oettingen on 04 Jan 1783 and died in Bechhofen in 1864. She was a daughter of Jonas Hirsch Gutmann in Oettingen and his wife Theres. Raphael and his wife Berta had a daughter Jeanette (see above) and three sons (one was named David and had two sons = Julius and Max).
- (D) Heinrich Heymann and wife Helene had two children = Otto (17 Jul 1889 12 Dec 1928) and Jenny (28 Oct 1890 13 Jun 1996), who died in Stuttgart. Before World War II Jenny had worked as a teacher at the "Goethe Gymnasium" (= college) in Ludwigsburg near Stuttgart but emigrated to London (England) in 1939 and only returned to Stuttgart in 1947.
- (E) Helene's father Carl Bruell was born on 27 Feb 1834 in Lichtenfels and died on 10 Nov 1894 in Fuerth. His wife Pauline nee Brandeis was born on 19 May 1837 and died on 24 Dec 1895 in Fuerth. Helene had a brother Louis Bruell in Munich who married Regina nee Bruell. Their children were Fritz (1888 ?), Ernst (1890 ?), Elisabeth (1892 1894), Karl I (1893 1893), Karl II (1895 ?)
