(06) ADOLPH lived in Noerdlingen by 1911

(07) MAX (born 7 Jun 1889 Aufhausen) became a merchant in Gunzenhausen and married Martha nee Guckenheimer (23 Jul 1901 Dinkelsbuehl - November 1979 Jamaica, Queens, New York), children = Manfred 19 Nov 1925 Nuernberg, Ernst 27 May 1927 Nuernberg - family lived in Stuttgart since 1934 before emigration to the USA in 1939

(08) BERTHA (born 22 Nov 1886 Aufhausen) married David Heimann in Oberdorf (born 6 Jul 1879 as son of Urias Heimann + wife Klothilde nee Gruensfelder) couple had three children = Heinrich 4 Dec 1910 (emigrated to Palestine in 1933), Martin Udo 10 May 1913 (emigrated to Argentina in 1937), Ludwig Carl 1 May 1929 (emigrated to the USA in 1939 together with his parents). David Heimann originally took over his father's business in Gunzenhausen in 1901 but later returned to Oberdorf and finally started a chicken farm together with his brother Hermann in Lakewood, New Jersey USA after their emigration from Germany.

(09) SALI

(08) LINA married in 1920 the banker Karl Weinmann (born 21 Jul 1890 in Altenmuhr) in Gunzenhausen, couple had two sons = Berthold 1922 and Max 1926. Lina died in 1929. Husband Karl Weinmann remarried in 1930 Gretl Eberhardt from Massbach. Family left Gunzenhausen in 1934 for Munich and later emigrated to Argentina. Karl Weinmann died in 1948. His son Max married thereafter Edith Strauss from Stuttgart (two children = Lilian + Carlos). Brother Berthold Weinmann lived in Buenos Aires and married Lore Schwarz from Stuttgart.
