DAVID STERNGLANZ

real estate dealer, he lived for some time in Tarboro, North Carolina USA,
citizen of Noerdlingen since 1899
born 10 Feb 1854 Ederheim, died 13 Feb 1930 Noerdlingen
(parents = Meier Sternglanz + wife Mina nee Vogel)

married 6 Nov 1878 in Tarboro, North Carolina USA

SARA ALEXANDER

born 9 Aug 1858 Hengstfeld (near Gerabronn), died 7 Mar 1923 Noerdlingen
(parents = master weaver Isaac Alexander + wife Therese nee Neumann) (A)

CHILDREN:

- (01) THERESE (B) 29 Mar 1881 (born in Tarboro, North Carolina USA)
married 11 Feb 1902 in Ellwangen
horsedealer Leopold Neuburger in Ellwangen
(parents = Samson Neuburger + Rosa nee Stern)
born 11 Aug 1875 Lauchheim -
died 14 Aug 1928 Gravenhage (Holland)
(couple was divorced 29 Feb 1924 in Ellwangen)
- (02) ALBERT 03 Jan 1883 (born in Stuttgart)
(born Saly ?) moved to Bamberg and married 5 July 1911
Jenny Fleissig (born 4 Apr 1892 in Bamberg)
parents = Henry Fleissig + Konstanze nee Loebel

(A) Isaac Alexander's father Alexander Hirsch was born in Moenchsdeggingen
and moved to Hengstfeld. Isaac Alexander himself was buried at the Jewish
Cemetery of Noerdlingen.

(B) Therese Neuburger changed name again to "Sternglanz" after divorce and
moved to Noerdlingen. Children out of this marriage (born Ellwangen) :

- (01) HANS SIEGFRIED 27 Dec 1902 - 14 Apr 1903 (died in Ellwangen)
- (02) GERTRUD BIANCA 23 Jun 1904 - ? married in June 1935 in Munich
Benno Ludwig Weil (born 19 Jul 1903 in Munich)
he was born Catholic as son of Gustav Weil
and his wife Frieda nee Uihlfelder
(couple may have left Munich before 1933 ?)

Therese Sternglanz was deported from Munich during the holocaust and
"disappeared" somewhere in Eastern Europe.
