## ISIDOR ASCHER

traditional name = Ascher Dow ben Ascher according to grave inscription hop and pitch dealer in Noerdlingen born 29 Aug 1843 Moenchsroth, died 29 Mar 1892 Noerdlingen (parents = Amson Ascher + wife Karoline nee Gutmann)

married 19 Oct 1869 in Noerdlingen

ERNESTINE (born Esther) WEIL born 20 Mar 1849 Aufhausen, died 23 Jan 1913 Noerdlingen (parents = Jakob Weil + wife Adelheid Schwabacher)

- (D) Edith Ascher (19 Aug 1923 27 Aug 2002) also died in Union NJ, maybe she was Moritz' daughter or wife ?
- (A) grave inscription = "Die Arbeit zu ehren / und redlich zu streben / die Deinen zu lieben / das war Dein Leben"
- (B) Hedwig Ascher moved 1937 from Noerdlingen to Munich, finally living with Amalie Ascher (?) at 105 Klenze Strasse, but she was deported in 1942 from Noerdlingen to Riga, where she was killed. The daughter Ruth Gisela was born on 6 Feb 1919 in Noerdlingen and emigrated 1939 to the USA. A second daughter was Erna (Ernestine) 22 Dec 1916 15 Nov 1922, buried in Noerdlingen. A third daughter was stillborn 24 Mar 1915.
- (C) Jakob Ascher started in 1905 a wholesale business with furniture metal fittings and coffin decorations at A 85 Hintere Reimlinger Gasse in Noerdlingen the company's name was "Sueddeutsche Moebelbeschlagindustrie Jakob Ascher". In 1909 he started another business as a paint dealer.

Jewish Cemetery of Moenchsdeggingen has 3 Ascher graves of children who died very young in Noerdlingen before the Jewish Cemetery of Noerdlingen was set up (see birth list above 1-3):

(I) KELA (KAULA) 23 Jul 1871 - 12 Apr 1875 (grave 139) (II) ASCHER ZWI born ?, died 23 Sep 1875 (grave 143) (III) SELIGMANN LOEW born 1871 ?, died 1875 (grave 147) (called Sigmund)

Parents were noted on these three children's graves as "Ascher Dow" (=Isidor) Ascher + wife Ernestine
