SAMUEL MARX iron dealer in Noerdlingen since 1868, business company in hops and iron with brother Lazarus Marx, moved to Munich in 1902, born 9 Apr 1845 Moenchsroth, died ? in Munich (parents = Jakob Loew Marx + wife Jeanette nee Hirsch) (A) married 25 Aug 1868 in Noerdlingen MARGOLITHA KOHN born 3 Dec 1848 Wassertruedingen, died ? in Munich (parents = Haenlein S Kohn + wife Zierle nee Gutmann) CHILDREN (all born in Noerdlingen): (01) SOFIE (born Sara) 02 Jul 1869 - ? married 15 Nov 1888 in Noerdlingen Max Regensteiner, manufacturer in Augsburg (02) MARIE (born Merla) 28 Oct 1870 - ? married 5 May 1891 in Noerdlingen Dr med Salomon Hirsch, practitioner in Hannover, born 18 Feb 1866 Hannover parents = Isakk Hirsch + wife Merla/Martha n. Kohn (03) HEDWIG 03 Jan 1872 - 04 Apr 1872 (04) HUGO 30 Oct 1873 - 15 Sep 1945 (in emigration) (citizen of Munich since 1901) he had a banking business in Munich together with his son Dr Karl Marx (born 6 Mar 1903 Munich) Hugo and Karl Marx managed to emigrate (05) WILLI (Wilhelm) 14 Jan 1875 - September 1966 (died as "William") (born Benjamin) (B) he died in Leawood, Johnson County, Kansas USA (06) SIGMUND (B) 26 Jan 1876 - ? merchant in Munich, married 2 Dec 1906 in Munich Emma Westheimer, born 2 Mar 1885 in Munich parents = Julius Westheimer + Sofie nee Kohn (07) SARA 26 Jan 1876 - ? (08) HERMANN 21 Jul 1877 - ? (became an agent for hats in Munich since 1924) (09) IDA 15 Mar 1884 - December 1968 (B) (died in Hackensack, Bergen, New Jersey USA) she left Germany in 1939 she married 7 Sep 1905 in Munich Siegfried Lauchheimer (21 Jun 1869 Stuttgart - 19 May 1925 Munich) son of Laemle Lauchheimer (1820 Pflaumloch - 1892 Stuttgart)

(10) ZERLINE (called Lina)	04 Aug 1885 - 20 Jul 1928 (died in Hannover) married 25 Dec 1907 in Munich merchant Richard Molling in Munich 24 Jan 1880 in Hannover - 13 Jul 1941 London (parents = Adolf Molling + Rosalie nee Benjamin)
(11) EMMA (1 st twin)	25 Mar 1888 - 04 May 1888 (died in Noerdlingen)
(12) BERTHA (2 nd twin)	25 Mar 1888 – 30 Mar 1888 (died in Noerdlingen)

(B) In 1913 Ida, Sigmund and Wilhelm bought the printshop "Graphia Druckerei and Kunstanstalt Beger & Röckel" in Munich and later took in Josef Cramer as partner. In 1939 Ida emigrated to Cuba, later she obviously moved on to the USA.
