(10) KLARA		23 Oct 1882 – ? married 18 Apr 1912 in Nuernberg Samuel Siegfried Koehler from Nuernberg

(11)	MAX	07 Oct 1884 - ? (emigrated from Nuernberg in 1936) married Lilli Klara Eismann, born 19 Oct 1901 Nuernberg
(12)	LINA	21 Nov 1885 - 07 Aug 1886 (died in Noerdlingen)
(13)	ISAAK (later Fritz)	22 Jan 1888 - ? (called Fritz since 1909, emigrated in 1937)
